

Smoking Policy

The statutory framework for the Early Years Foundation Stage April 17 3.56 details all necessary requirements on the position of smoking. Bloom Day Nursery will adhere to all recommended requirements.

Bloom Day Nursery holds a strict **No Smoking Policy**. Smoking is prohibited on all areas of Nursery grounds apart from the designated smoking area located at the furthest point from the building and outdoor play area to which children will not have access. Smoking includes all cigarettes, cigars and electrical smoking devices.

Staff wishing to smoke must remove the Bloom Day Nursery Uniform and wear alternative clothing. They must thoroughly wash hands and be sure that they do not smell of cigarettes before going back into the main nursery areas in contact with children. If you are smoking on your way into work please follow the above guidance.

Parents are asked not to distinguish any smoking device on the Bloom Day Nursery car park or entrance areas. All visitors to the setting must be made aware of the No Smoking policy when signing themselves into the Nursery provision.

Bloom Day Nursery practitioners are not allowed to smoke whilst wearing Bloom Day Nursery uniform.
