

Admissions Policy

At Bloom Day Nursery we welcome children aged from 6 weeks to 5 years old.

Securing a place

If you wish to secure a place at Bloom Day nursery complete the application form and return to the nursery. A deposit of one weeks fees is required to secure your place which is deducted from the first months fees.

Fees

Fees at Bloom Day Nursery cover:

- Quality Early Education and Childcare
- Meals, snacks and fresh milk (not formula)
- Nappies, wipes and nappy cream if needed
- Access to a wide range of age appropriate resources and equipment
- Access to a huge variety of craft materials and baking products for 'take home' activities
- Outings to local park
- Celebrations including festivals and graduation ceremonies

Fees are payable by standing order on the 1st of each month for the month ahead.

Fees are payable for 51 weeks of the year and include bank holidays. (we have a limited number of term time places, please contact the nursery for more information)

Fees are reviewed each January and details can be found on the application form for the current year.

From January 2018 the daily rate throughout the nursery will be £48.

Funding

Bloom Day Nursery offer funded places for *2, 3 and 4 year olds*.

Settling in

We provide three 2hour long settling in sessions completely free of charge. These are usually arranged for the week before your child starts.

During the first session, you will be introduced to your child's key practitioner and the other practitioners within your child's room. You will also get a chance to complete any outstanding paperwork. We would ask that you leave your child for at least 30 minutes during this first session. You are more than welcome to have a cuppa in the reception during this time.

During the second session, we ask that you leave your child for at least an hour if not for the majority of the session to enable them to start to bond with their key carer.

During the 3rd session your child will stay with us for meal and we ask that you leave them with us for the duration of this session.
